Club members give many hours of their time providing services to their community. This often takes the form of structures such as sporting & recreational facilities, historic monuments, rest areas, parks & gardens.

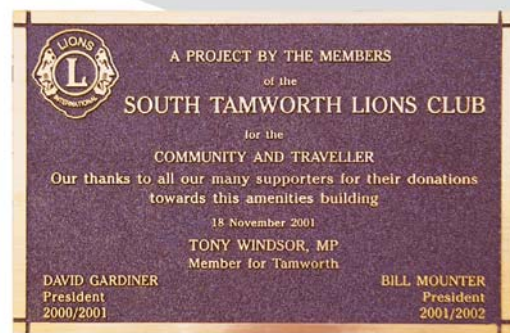
